THE CERTAINTY AND URGENCY OF THE RAPTURE



In 1 Corinthians 15:51-52, the apostle Paul presents a graphic description of the Rapture's instantaneous nature: "Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed." This "twinkling of an eye" explain the incredible speed at which this event will unfold. This speed is immeasurable.

3. The Meeting in the Air

One of the most profound aspects of the Rapture is the reunion of believers with their Lord in the air. It is written in 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, "For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord." This moment of reunion and transformation defies explanation or human comprehension, emphasizing the certainty and suddenness of the Rapture.

4. The Transformation of Our Bodies

(1 Corinthians 15:51-52)

In Corinthians, Paul unveils the mystery of the Rapture, describing the transformation of believers' bodies. "Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed." No matter how weak or disabled your body might be now, a day is coming- a twinkling moment in time is coming when this mortal body shall put on immortality and you shall be changed; Hallelujah.

5. The Urgency of Preparedness

Given the imminent and sudden nature of the Rapture, Scripture beseeches believers to live with vigilance and readiness. In Matthew 24:42-44, Jesus Himself implores, "Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into. Therefore, you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." We must note that the rapture has no second batch. It going to be a one-time event that will happen speedily and suddenly. Get prepared!
